1. Coach Ehler gave overview of grants and national lacrosse convention attended by Coach Ehler and Kuhblank.

2. Al Forbes, President:

- Introduction of coaches and board members
- Requested that players/parents check contact list to verify email addresses and phone numbers
- Explained that lacrosse is a pay-to-play sport; checks should be made out to FBL
- Promoted FIT/FBL lacrosse expo on Saturday, January 26
- Opening Day: We will make this a special occasion since the event marks the first lax team at RHS. Photo of team will be taken, bronzed, and put on future wall ball
- Sponsorships and fundraisers are best ways to cover player fees

3. Coach Kuhblank

- Try-out dates: January 28 & 29, 2013
- This is a "cut" sport for boys. There are 44 positions available (22 JV/22V); there will be no cuts for girls.
- Practice site: top field at RHS
- Requirements: players need physical on file and US lacrosse membership. Dr. Rahal will perform physicals for free.
- Equipment requirements: 1st week: sticks and balls. There are equipment packages available through Sportstop.com
- Grant status: Grant allowed us to receive field gear for 24 players and 1 goalie (boys and girls). Boys: Helmets will be given to Varsity players; other equipment will go to Varsity first and then move to JV as needed.
- Games will be held at McClarty stadium
- Practice times: Boys: 4-6 pm (M-F and Saturday morning); Girls: 3:45pm
