## RHS Lacrosse Coaches

### ○ Coaches:

1. FBL coaches meeting scheduled for October 23<sup>rd</sup>
2. Fall opportunities
  - Coach Kuhblank (boys) will continue to work with same group of boys from summer. 2 away games are scheduled for November 9<sup>th</sup> in Vero Beach; possible tournament in December.
  - Coach Johnson (girls) Possible camp at University of Florida in late December- 2 nights; Champion Challenge – 1 day clinic at Disney
3. Game ball requirements
  - New regulations state that balls must be seamless and have the FHSAA logo.
  - We will have to supply the balls: at present, games are Tu & Th; 1 Friday 16 games for boys & girls (possibly 18 if Edgewood joins). We will need approximately 80 game balls plus practice balls. We will need approximately 10 balls/game for both boys & girls... JV can use old balls; Varsity must use the new balls. Order balls through the Ball Store.
  - John will get information from next FBL meeting; Kuhblank will get a definitive number – possibly get a ball grant.
4. Introduction of additional guests (parents of girl player)
  - Parents indicated that they had a friend who won the lottery and might be interested in funding lax

### ○ Uniforms/Equipment/Grant Status

1. Uniforms – Coach Kuhblank indicated that boys need practice pinnies; no need to order practice shorts. Coach Johnson indicated that several girls kept their practice

pinnies but have all game uniforms accounted for; Coaches need to inventory uniforms by the next meeting and place order immediately after.

2. Equipment – order for First Stick needs to be in by 10/11. Grant will provide goalie equipment. Committee discussed purchasing bags for players but decided this could be a possible fundraiser.

- Miscellaneous: January 27 is the first day players can touch a stick. February 18 – first game; Weekend opening – February 15.

## **RHS Lacrosse Committee**

- John Bandy, Program Director
  1. New committee members elected (Marty Smouse – Field Coordinator – boys; Domenick Tutera – Auxilliary Coordinator – boys); Open position – Auxilliary Coordinator – girls)
  2. Announcing – we can no longer do play by play announcing; can only be done on stoppages in play; announcers must be 18.
  3. Debit card – FBL will issue a debit card for petty cash - \$500/month
  4. Trainer – Required for all games for liability issues (both JV and V); \$17/hour x 3.5 x 20 = approx. \$1,190. The home team provides the trainer. Coach Ein Stites is teacher and trainer.
- Amy Moon, Chairperson – Fundraising
  1. Committee discussed opening day – February 15. Amy suggested that we get radio broadcasting; raffles; Cocoa PD would like to do demos, face painting canine demonstrations; parent in attendance said that he deals with 30 local restaurants and could get 20% return on food.
  2. Daytona – may not be an option this year due to closing of back part. If we can go ahead with this fundraiser, we would need more volunteers this year.
  3. Golf tournament – possible in the spring – end of April, early May
  4. T-Shirts – good fundraiser - \$10/shirt; blankets for the cold weather games!
  5. Cookie Dough sales – we will begin this immediately; easy fundraiser – great profit. Proceeds will be applied directly to players accounts.
  6. Sponsorship drive: sponsor list needs to be updated. Returning sponsors will receive a discount (10% off if they renew). We will send out letters to last year's sponsors and give the \$ back to the players. Sponsor renewals from last year's seniors will go into the general fund.
  7. Team pictures – Amy offered to take pictures of the players and would give the

money back to the league. Doug indicated that the current photographer has a player on the team and is a personal friend. It was suggested that he put out a bid or put some money back into the team.

8. Casino Bus Trip – John has organized this event in the past for the football team. It has been very successful. Tickets are pre-sold, \$50/ticket or 2 for \$90 (this includes bus ride; \$15 in slot play; drinks to and from). The bus hold approximately 40-45 people. After the first 25 people, everything else is a profit. On the bus, we can tickets to raffle off baskets. Tentative date: January 18
9. Mulch party – sell mulch and deliver it to neighborhoods. Possible charges: \$1/bag; \$1/bag-delivery; \$1/bag -lay the mulch.
