- Coaches
 1. Game schedule – Doug will send copy to Jim to post on site.

 3. Tryouts: 1/28/13 – Players must have physical and US Lax membership on file.
 4. Next parent meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, January 15th at 6:30 pm, RHS cafeteria. Dr. Osorio has offered to address proper mouth guard protection.

 1. FBL Meeting review:

2. FBL members are going to Athletic Directors at various schools to promote program.
 - d. FIT player opportunities- FIT is offering Zulu league as well as LandSharks (travel team). It is possible that we can run our team with LandSharks in summer. Tryouts for LandSharks is 12/9 (boys only). There will be only 2 tournaments in January; team will start back up in April/May (after school season ends). Cost: \$225

 1. Al gave overview of upcoming fundraising opportunities
