Proceedings: Meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m. at Malibu's Restaurant by Al Forbes, President.

RHS Lacrosse Coaches (Ann Ehler, Doug Kuhblank)

Equipment/Grant Status:

1. Our main priority is to work on ordering uniforms. Doug/Ann should consider Stickhead as possible vendor. Boy's uniform will consist of shirts/shorts (home & away); girls - kilts/tank tops. Coaches will also look at duffel bags.
2. Coach Ehler gave overview of grants that have been received. Grant will cover padding, gloves, sticks, etc. Coaches will be going to coaches' convention in Philadelphia on 12/18. Grant is paying for airline, conference registration, hotel. Vendors will be present at convention. Al Forbes expressed interest in attending to meet with possible vendors. For future grants, we need to consider field equipment, tents with logos.
3. Florida Youth Lacrosse grant – we will use funds for equipment; we have to submit seasonal schedules of games. It is possible that we will have to do fundraiser for FL Youth Lax to replenish grant – grant requirement.
4. Shirt Sales – no progress to date

Growing our Program:

2. Boy's coaches – Doug will meet tomorrow with a volunteer at Fairglen who doesn't want a paid position; just wants to see the program succeed; 9th grade football coach possible JV coach.

 1. Marcia provided rough draft of financial report. She referenced Krispy Kreme – kids would get a percentage for everything over \$60.
 2. We will eventually post expenses on website and are getting a petty cash fund (\$200)

 1. Status on master contact list: Discussion centered around how to communicate with parents/kids...via text? Jim provided information on remote 1-to-1.com (?) as a possible way to send texts to players about cancellations or updates.
 2. John Bandy indicated that his wife is able to send texts to her student's parents – parent has to fill out information; this is a free service if you are an employee of BPS.
 3. New sponsors: If we solicit a new sponsor, we need to tell Jim what level they are
 4. Request was made to add financial report to website.

 1. New grant opportunity: Power Bright Future by Clorox – this involves a picture and 1,000 word essay. Grant is a voting grant – we need to promote voting on website. Ann Ehler will work with Shelly on grant.
