



Committee & Coaches Meeting Minutes

December 15, 2014

● Doug Kuhblank

- Purchased uniforms for varsity boys. He is still waiting on an invoice. The price was under \$2,300 (\$2,500 was budgeted for the uniforms). 25 uniforms were ordered, including 2 shirts per player (home/away).
- Wish list- Hudl was mentioned at the last meeting. Found out that it costs \$800 a year per team.
- In place of purchasing this video software, Doug talked to Brian Dillion. Brian offered to create highlight videos for interested athletes- \$250 per player, which includes 2 DVDs and will upload it to Youtube. Half of the cost will need to be paid up front and the rest of the payment is due at completion.
